The undersigned hereby waives and releases the Club and all persons connected with the Club from any and all liability for injury, damages or loss of any nature or death that they may suffer while on the said property of the Club.

The Applicant hereby agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Club and all persons connected in any way with the Club from any claim or claims brought by or on behalf of the undersigned or a member of their family as a result of any injury, damage or loss to the undersigned, howsoever caused.

Concussion Policy**

When an individual falls on the Land O Lakes Curling Club property and hits their head the following policy must be followed. This policy applies to anyone on the property owned by the Land O Lakes Curling Club.

1. Ask the person if they are ok.
2. If it is determined that they hit their head then 911 will be called.
3. Do not let the person leave the building.
4. An incident log must be filled out by the person convening the league or in charge of the event.
